## ITHUMBA TEAM

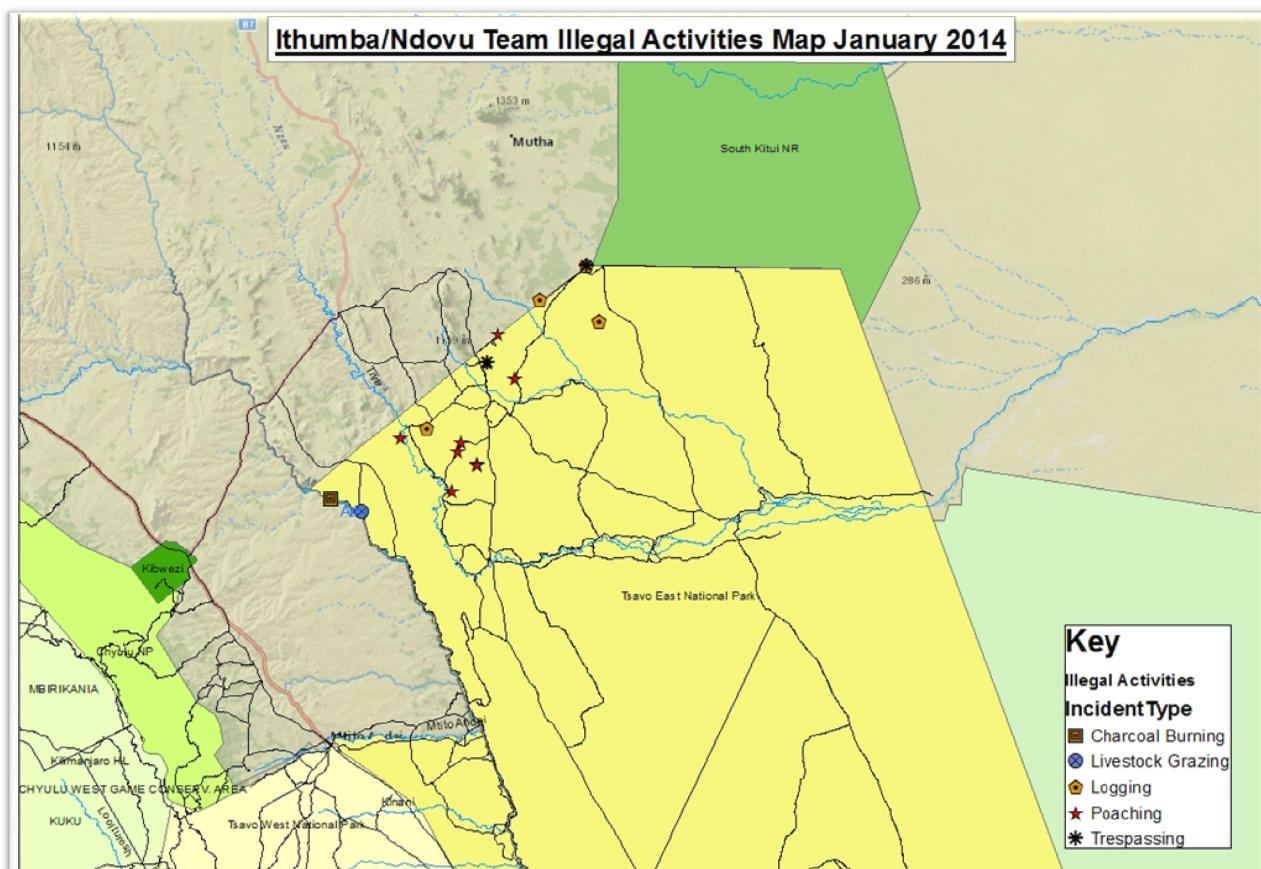
**PATROL AREA:** Northern sector of Tsavo East NP, northern boundary & Gazi

### MONTHLY SUMMARY

The Ithumba team discovered a recent elephant carcass which had been snared in the northern area and the tusks had been removed. They also came across extensive logging in the far northern area of Tsavo East and a considerable number of snares were collected, making 4 arrests.

While on patrol the team sighted a large bull elephant with severe poisoned arrow wounds and they camped nearby to monitor the elephant whilst waiting for the veterinary unit to arrive. The following day assisted by the Tiva team, the elephant was darted but sadly had to be euthanized due to its severe wounds.

**POACHERS ARRESTED**
