## SECURITY & INCIDENTS

### LIFTING SNARES 3/09/2014

The new Yatta team is still operating in Meru National Park. They lifted several big snares at the Murondia area set for giraffes/elephants



### SNARED GIRAFFE 7/09/14

The team found a giraffe carcass in the Kielu area, which had died from being snared



### GIRAFFE CARCASS 8/09/14

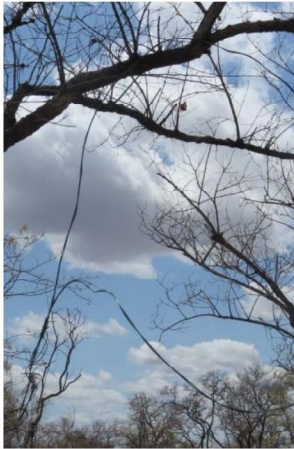
A 2nd giraffe carcass was found again in the Kielu area, having died caught in a snare





**LIFTING SNARES**  
8/09/14

A large snare set in the trees was removed by the team before it killed another giraffe.



**BUSHMEAT POACHER**  
9/09/14

The team arrested a poacher in Meru NP who was setting a large number of heavy duty snares



**POACHER ARRESTED**  
10/09/14

The team arrested an ivory poacher operating in Meru NP with poisoned arrows and camping equipment





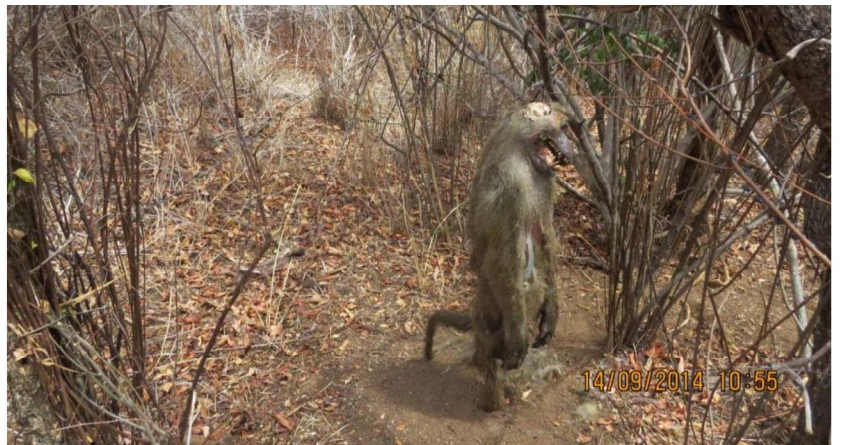
**SNARED HYAENA**  
14/09/14

The team found a decomposing hyaena carcass, which had died in a snare



**SNARED WILDLIFE**  
14/09/14

The team also found a baboon and buffalo carcass which had both died in snares; the poacher not returning to remove the bushmeat



**SNARES LIFTED**  
22/09/14

A large number of medium sized snares were lifted from Meru NP within the Kindani area having been set to capture wildlife



SNARED BUSHBUCK  
29/09/14

A snared bushbuck carcass was found in Meru NP having fallen victim to one of countless snares set in the area
