

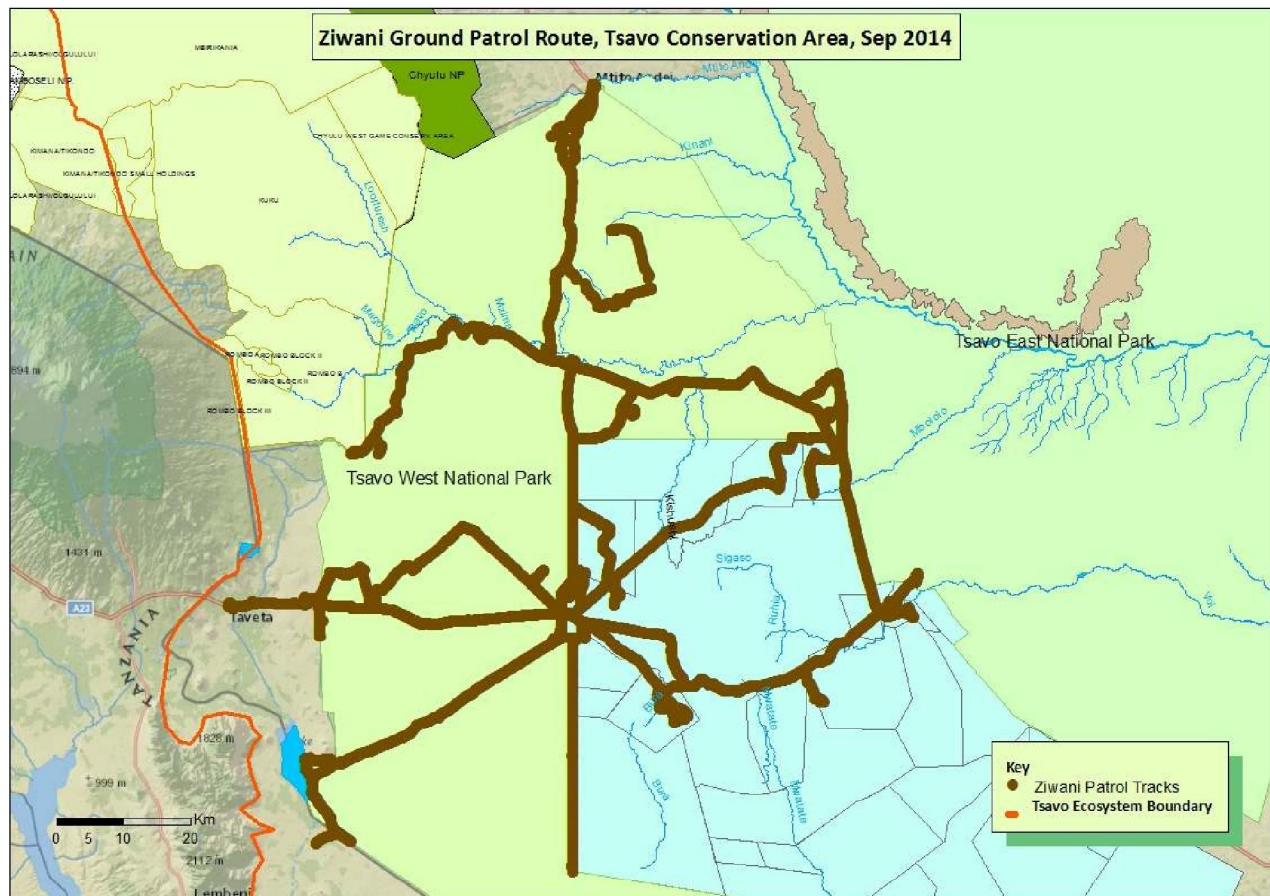

### ELEPHANT CARCASS 3/09/14

The Ziواني team discovered an elephant carcass. Sadly the tusks had already been removed by poachers



### LIFTING SNARES 6/09/14

The team lifted a number of wire snares targeting smaller game within the Oza Ranch area



### BUSH FIRE 9/09/14

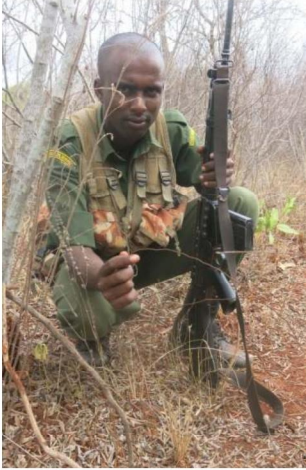
A fire was lit on one of the ranches by bordering communities, the fire luckily did not spread too far





LIFTING SNARES  
12/09/2014

The team lifted snares near a sisal plantation at Mgeno area which were set to capture small antelope



POACHER'S CAVE  
15/09/14

The team discovered a cave used by a poacher and found poisoned arrows and camping equipment



ELEPHANT TAILS  
15/09/14

The team found 3 tails of a decimated elephant, used in traditional ceremonies and sold on the black market





**RESCUED KUDU**  
18/09/2014

The team rescued a lesser kudu which had been abandoned on the ranches and took it to the DSWT Tsavo HQ for care



**CHARCOAL BURNING**  
22/09/2014

A charcoal burner was arrested who later turned out also to be a bushmeat poacher known to the KWS



**POACHING SNARE**  
23/09/2014

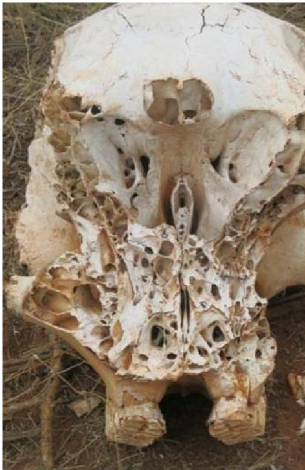
The team discovered a very crude device to snare and injure animals. This was the sole of a shoe with nails laid on a wildlife path
