


ELEPHANT CARCASS 3/09/14

The team discovered a cave used by a poacher and found poisoned arrows and camping equipment




ELEPHANT TAILS 15/09/14

A charcoal burner was arrested who later turned out also to be a bushmeat poacher known to the KWS






POACHING SNARE 23/09/2014
