Monthly Summary

As the dry season continues there is a high influx of people coming into the Parks & Protected areas to carry out illegal activities. Snare numbers have increased in comparison to the last few months, particularly in KARI ranch. This month 2 poachers were arrested, one in possession of 53 snares and the other with a Bow and 4 arrows. Decreasing water reserves are making wild animals vulnerable to poaching as they congregate near the remaining water supply. A point of concern will be protecting rhino dispersal areas in KARI ranch that is not managed by KWS. A joint security effort by KWS, SHELDRICK, MPT and KARI would be a possible solution to this threat.

Wood carving is a big business around the Chyulu Hills area and is a major threat to the last remaining indigenous forests. During the course of the month 4 wood carvers were arrested around Kisula and Kenzili areas, all had large amounts of wood carvings made out of illegally harvested wood from indigenous trees. It is believed these wood carvers have strong links with dealers working out of Nairobi. The carving workshops at Mbuinzau town are supplying the market in Nairobi need to be investigated t ensure the wood harvested is of a sustainable source. 2 charcoal burners were arrested on the upper part of KARI.

On the Community Project side, the first phase of the Kibwezi fence line has been completed. The community members are very happy with the Trusts work as this fence resolves their problems of human-wildlife conflict. Two schools benefited with excursions into Tsavo West National Park. The schools were Mutantheu and Kimboo primary schools. During the trips the children were taught the importance of wildlife and need to conserve it. The children had an opportunity to see wildlife in a natural setting. This was their first trip into the Park so the students were thrilled to have this opportunity.
