Monthly Summary

The ongoing drought and poverty in Kenya remains the biggest conservation dilemma for the coming months. The team was based at Kenze because of the reported case of poaching at Umani. Around Umani area, on the park side, 5 shooting platforms were destroyed, indicating that there could be some poachers targeting the elephants. The team concentrated on the area and managed to arrest the alleged 2 poachers who have been masquerading as informers of FOC. This was a huge success because one had escaped last month.

The team concentrated on Metava area and managed to arrest 4 people, 3 cattle grazers and 1 charcoal burner. At Kisula area, 6 wood carvers were arrested in 2 different hideouts. 2 of them had been arrested last month.

The Team carried out Community initiatives in the middle of the month. 2 schools namely Isaani and Mikuyuni primary schools benefitted with school trips to Tsavo west national park. Being the first time for the school kids to visit the Park, they were very excited to see wildlife during the trip. Isaani pupils also received the donation of stationary. The parents were very grateful for that gesture and requested for more such opportunities in future. The third phase of fence line is going on and in progress. The cutline has been done.
