Monthly Summary

The Chyulu Team patrolled between the 20th & 30th of November. Due to the arrival of the rains poaching activities have reduced as people are busy tending to their farms & cultivating crops. Charcoal burning remains high, it seems much of it is currently being done by charcoal burners, 1 illegal cattle grazer and 2 wood carvers were arrested during Patrols in November. As the Team has been patrolling Kibwezi forest, very little charcoal burning is taking place inside the protected area. It seems most charcoal burners have relocated to other areas of operation. Wild animal sightings have increased in Kibwezi forest, but in the park they are still scarce.

The Team's Community Outreach has really taken off on a positive note. The team showed one wildlife video at Jasho village. Demand for wildlife products is high, but the supply is limited. The Team proposes for another tree nursery at Umani to cater for the huge demand. The Kibwezi forest fence line is being constructed; this will reduce the conflict between the people and wildlife.
