Charcoal burning illegal activity and is developing so much that most of it is for commercial sale rather than for subsistence use. The illegal harv uncovered during an arrest, this trade has the Team carrying out further investigations as to the extent and workings of this op patrol with Mtito team during the first 2 weeks of the month which proved to be very successful as more people were arrested a The Kibwezi Forest fence line is being constructed in order to keep the elephants away from crops and as such has received a community. There was a meeting with all stakeholders for the review of Kibwezi forest management plan and a positive and er all stakeholders.
