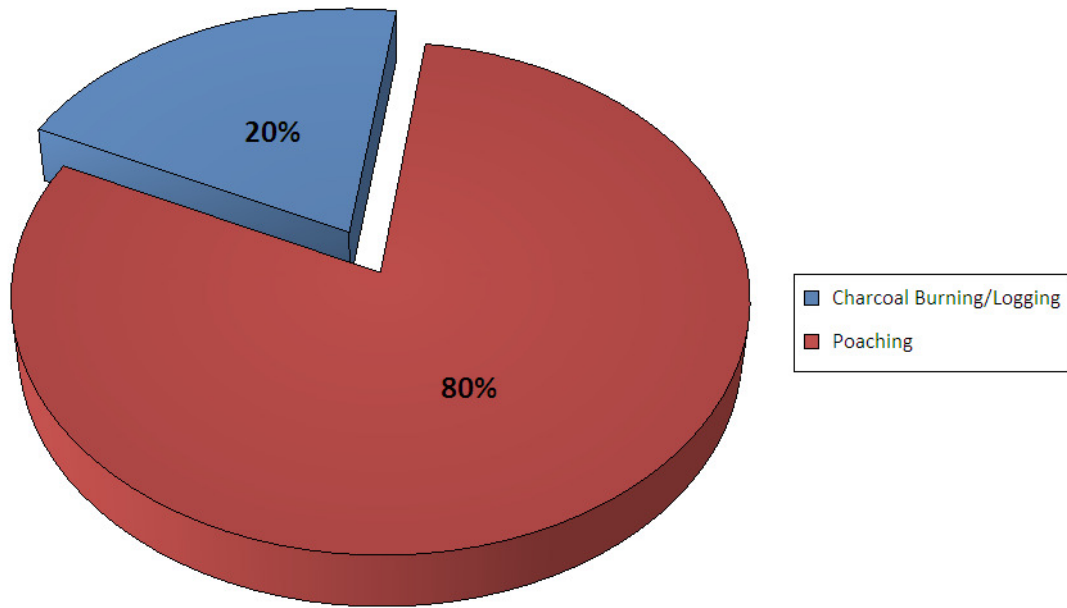

Monthly Summary

FARU-JULY 2013

The team continued with its operations as usual. Rukinga ranch, Mbulia, Ndara and the Rhino block were among the areas that received most attention. In general, of all these, the intensity of illegal activities remained low or none at all on most of these areas except for Mbulia area from where 423 snares were lifted and 5 apprehensions made; 4 being booked and, a charcoal burner receiving stern warning on the fact that he was a part of the ranch group membership.

The Tsavo river- Man eaters, Kyulu and Manga areas also received some attention from the team. These areas were calm and recorded very minimum sign of human interference.

In total, 427 snares were lifted, most likely the highest figure ever!

Meanwhile, the team takes a short break for the last half of the month, but hoping to resume at end-month in readiness for more work ahead.

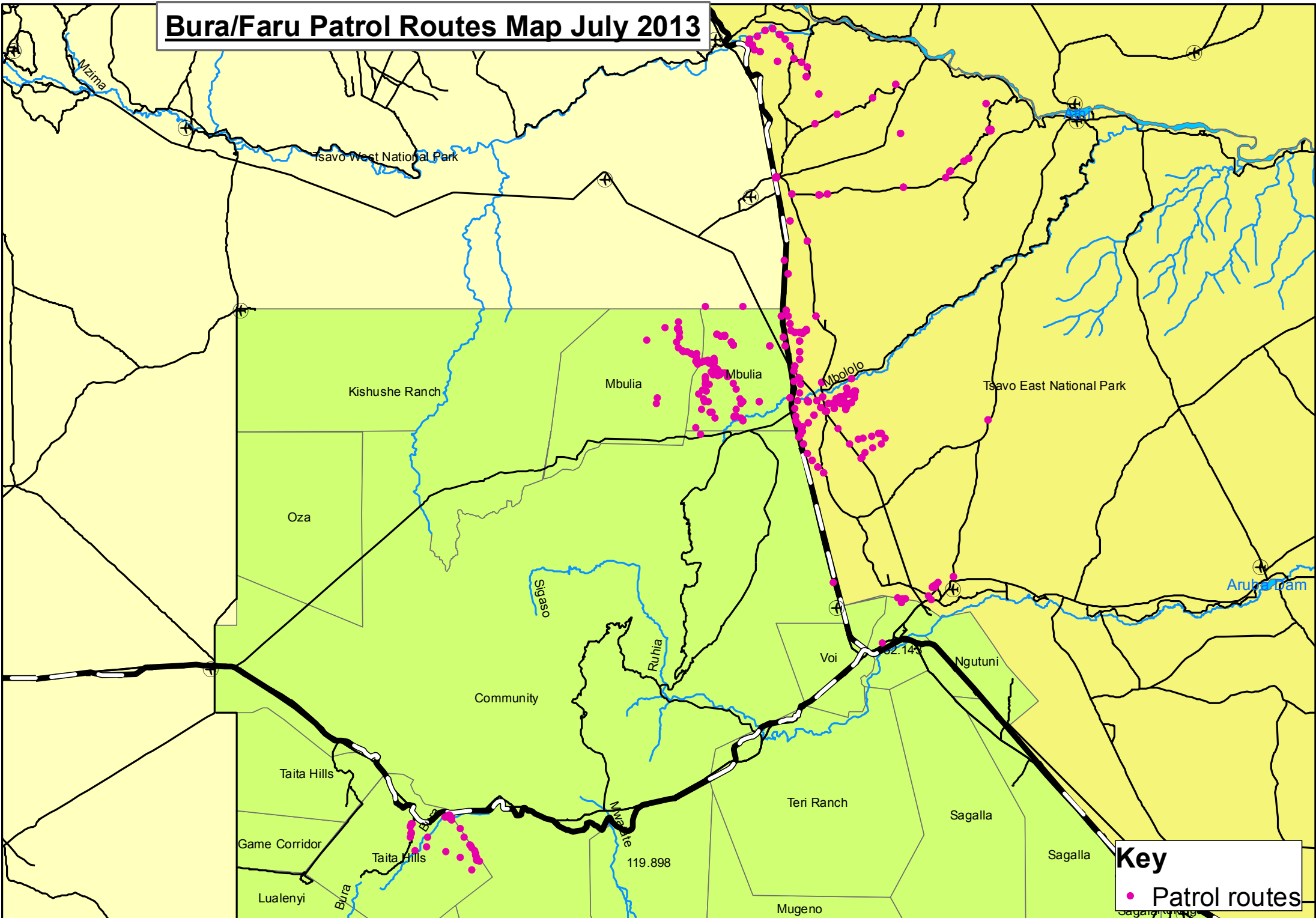

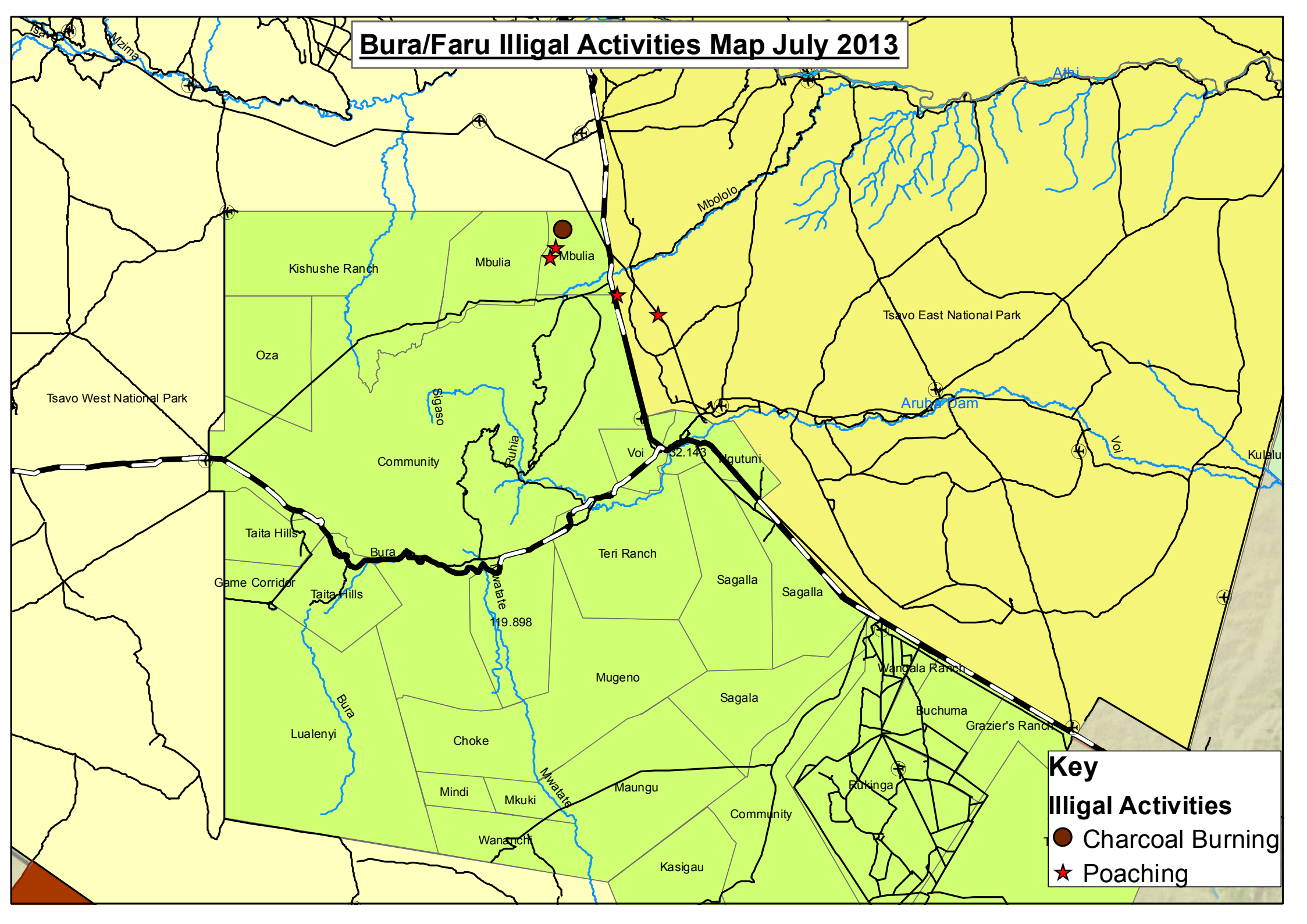
