Monthly Summary

The team started its august patrols by revisiting some of the areas covered in the month of June this year. Most of this month general area and along Athi River which is part of the Park boundary. The Team had intended to base patrols in these area as patrols for quite sometime. The Team saw many signs of poachers entering the Park putting pressure on the Park's resources

In the first week of the month the Team concentrated around ithumba general. During the dry spell a lot of wildlife tend to cong source is at the Ithumba Stockade. Many wild elephants have been see in the area as other water points have dried up. The Te near water sources in the Park and hence following the wildlife's movements is logical as this is were the poachers will tend to on a broken down windmill at Ndiandasa.

During the second week of the month the team moved to Gazi. This area has endured large amounts of logging and charcoal seemed to have been timely as it appeared that the charcoal burners were regrouping to prepare to start cutting huge trees for charcoal burners light fires at the bottom of the tree to fell down the trees. The Team lay ambushes and arrested one charcoa booked at Kibwezi police station.

On patrolling the fence-line and talking to informers it seems most of the poacher entry points/routes were being used on daily and managed to arrest a notorious poacher. He was caught with18 snares made from wire which had been vandalized from the Mutomo police station. At Mkua-nima area there are reports that cattle grazers are vandalizing the fence by placing a stone on strand with a stick to let livestock go in and out. This has forced the fence attendants to be switching the energizer machine an fence.

When patrolling the Kona ya nyati area, fresh footprints moving in and out of the park were seen. The Team attempted laying lifted 176 small snares in that area. The Team also found dried bush-meat at a poacher's hideout nearby. The hideout looked a many days. The next day the Team managed to arrest a poacher who was busy checking some large cable snares along the r station.

On patrolling near Tsavo safari camp, a poacher who was walking on the road saw the vehicle and dropped a sack of bush me Team could not apprehend the man but searched the nearby bushes and lifted a total of 98 small snares. The Team came acrealso found, it is suspected to have been the hideout of the runaway poacher. Along the top of the Yatta towards Nthalakana air recently. There were many footprints crossing the Yatta plateau. The Team revisited Macho-kobo area where a big elephant si 16 snares targeting small game wer lifted.

On 28/8/2010 the Team held a security meeting at Voi park headquarters. All the 5 team leaders who man the sheldricks de-s was tasked with a defined area of operation to ensure that poaching comes down and elephant poaching is tackled effeciently. the use of poisoned arrows and snaring is on the rise.

In the first week of the month the Team attended the grand opening a classroom at Tsavo Primary School. There was also a p namely Kasaala and Tsavo primary schools. The occasion was attemded by local leaders from the area.

The Team organized a sports weekend with the yuong. This was a great success as a football competition at kasaala playing a good relationship between the Team members and the youth.
