Monthly Summary

Patrols for the month of February were mainly concentrated around major waterholes, were wildlife tend to congregate during the dry season. There was an increase in illegal activities, especially shooting hides at the waterholes. The Team frequented most of the waterholes where several fresh shooting hides were destroyed. It is of interest that recent months have indicated that poachers have opted to hunt for big game as opposed to snaring of small-medium game which used to be common in the Tsavo Northern area.

The Team was able to recover 1 tusk from an elephant that had been snared by a cable wire and had six poisoned arrows wounds in its body. Another 2 tusks were recovered from a two weeks old carcass at Tundani area. Both tusk recoveries were handed over to KWS.

The Team laid ambush at Umbi area after receiving information from a reliable source that loggers had entered the Park. The men sadly managed to escape but the team recovered a bicycle and two beams of timber.

The Team took two schools for an ecological tour to the park. The schools were Kasaala and Kavete primary school. The pupils were very excited, very happy and promised to talk to their brothers and fathers who carry out poaching activities to change their ways. It is only through these young kids that one can bring meaningful change of mind set towards conservation for the future.
