Monthly Summary

The team worked for the first two weeks of the month of January and proceeded for a 15 days off-duty. During operations it was noted that there was an increase in the number of illegal human activities in the park compared with recent months. These ranged from snaring, honey hunting, logging, and hunting for the big game. Most of the footprints found were for honey hunting due to its peak season. The footprints were visiting baobab trees where bees like to build their hives and hence a common place for honey harvesters to check. Hunting for big game which had reduced during the rainy season seems to be going up especially close to waterholes. The Team has put in all the necessary measures in an effort to apprehend the poachers and keep the elephants and other big game protected.

The month's findings revealed several poacher gangs moving in groups of 4 or more, all well equipped to stay for longer periods deep in the park while hunting for big game, predominantly elephant.

The casuals continue working on the big task of opening up the new Yatta road. The Team anticipates completing this job in the next two months time.
