### **De-Snaring Report for October, 2011**

#### **Monthly Summary**

In October the illegal activities inside the park were lower than recent month's findings. This could be due to the pressure The DSWT Teams and KWS have exerted on the major watering points.

The only illegal activity that was prevalent this month was logging. Logging has increased especially around kyamanyenze and Tundani areas. They are doing their activities during the night and avoid using known routes when coming out of the park to avoid being apprehended. But The Team is becoming wise to these tactics and has plans to tackle the problem.

The Team found two tusks near the powerline/kasaala fence with the help of Aerial Unit. The tusks weighed 106kgs and were handed over to KWS for safe custody. The carcass was between 6 weeks to 2 months old and it had decomposed hence could not establish the exact cause of death. With the onset of the rains most of the community members are busy planting crop and hence the reduction of illegal activities inside the park.

The Team has managed to open around 15kms of new road from Nthalakana airstrip running on top Yatta towards the Kasaala/Athi fence line. A further 34kms of road is also in the pipeline for clearing. This will on the long run make patrols easier in more inaccessible areas. The casuals who come from the nearing community are doing a wonderful job.
