#### **Monthly Summary**

This month the Team has changed tactics in order to tackle the poachers' methods. The Team has noticed a shift in the trend months; the poachers have changed from predominantly laying snares to the use of bows and arrows. The areas which are be especially along the river Tiva, Tokotoko near Kyamanyenze, Sheldrick-blind, and Macho-kobo and Tundani area. Most poach poachers have also changed from using permanent hideouts to more mobile methods of using camps to become less predicta evade arrest. They will only spend the night once in one hideout before moving on elsewhere. It seems many are opting to hide active at night or early evening. This makes it more difficult to capture and arrest them.

The Team carried out patrols in the beginning and the end of the month, this was due to the fact that poachers have noticed th patrols in the last few days of the month to go for the monthly meetings down at Voi and carry out Community work. There is a month up to the first week of the month. That is why the Team has decided to change operations in order to become unpredict Team has also begun changing patrols hours so that they are carried out in the afternoon up to late evening. This has helped t wait for the big game at the shooting platforms at night near the water points. The Team has also taken to making spontaneou and this has yielded good results. Some of them go into hiding and this means they will not go poaching during that period.
