

Monthly Summary

A joint operation with Duma's team leader and several new recruits was performed in the Duwa area, which resulted in two snares being found and the arrest of two charcoal burners. The team was clued into the location of the charcoal burners by the sound of cutting wood. By quietly surrounding them, the team was able to block off any chance of escape and easily apprehend them so that they could be booked at Kibwezi Police Station.

Umani

Consistent with the previous month, large concentrations of game continue to be found around Umani. No illegal activity was spotted either, so this trend should continue.

Kenze

No actual elephants were seen on patrol around Kenze, but there were signs of a lot of elephant activity here. The team is hopeful that elephants will slowly become habituated and begin to be spotted more frequently throughout Kibwezi forest. For the time being they continue to move about almost exclusively under cover of darkness.

Algon

The team is still inconvenienced by a lack of charging facilities at Kenze base and continue to rely on Umani Camp to charge batteries for their radio, etc.







