#### **Monthly Summary**

This month proved to be very eventful for the team. It all started with the theft of the solar panels at Kaluku borehole and the team was called to help recover them. The team leader in conjunction with the Peregrine team laid an extensive intelligence network on the ground and with the help of the local administration and the Staff at Kaluku, the solar panels were recovered after two weeks. Afterwards the team relocated to the Chyulu hills and camped at the Utu base from where a joint operation with the Chyulu team was carried out. This operation saw 21 people arrested and many charcoal kilns being destroyed. The team returned to the Triangle where three poachers and two charcoal dealers were arrested.

The team attended a chief's baraza at Ngiluni on the 15th April to help solve the solar panel issue. The meeting was attended by Mr. Richard Muller. The team leader and Mr. Muller persuaded the villagers to cooperate in search for the solar panel which resulted in the villagers volunteering information that led to the recovery of the solar panels.
