Monthly Summary

The team started its operations by patrolling in the TWNP Triangle area, where the team focused mainly on the increase of illegal grazing and charcoal burning within the area. Working tirelessly to curb the problem, the other key area patrolled by the team was the area of Mbulia Ranch, where the team also patrolled frequently and lifted a lot of newly set snares. During operation in this area, 4 men were apprehended for poaching, the team also patrolled other areas like Mangelete where a further 2 men were apprehended, both in possession of bush meat. During patrols in Misani, an elephant carcass was sighted by the team which was killed through poison arrowing and the tusks had been cut off and taken by the poachers.

On the 18th of August another elephant carcass was sighted by the DSWT aerial unit in the area of Kilaguni , both tusks were intact and the Team assisted in the recovery of the tusks and hand over to KWS. The elephant was believed to have died a natural death.

On the community outreach projects, the team visited the Kamunyu Primary school and supplied sporting equipment to the school as well as desks which were donated and were highly appreciated by the school.
