#### **Monthly Summary**

This was an extremely busy month for the team as we concentrated mainly on the Mange'lete side where people had taken to illegally grazing their livestock inside the park. The team set numerous ambushes in the triangle in hope of catching the lampers who had been reported to be operating in the area. The team also came across a fresh elephant carcass with its tusks still intact but the major breakthrough for the team was the arrest of Kathuki the notorious poacher. He was arrested after a tip off from one of our informers and the team in conjunction with the KWS intelligence team swiftly moved into action and apprehended him with 30 kgs of dry meat inside a suitcase. He was transporting the meat to Kambu market using a public service vehicle.

With the return of our inverter the team has been able to carry out several video shows which are being welcomed with a great enthusiasm by the local community whose interest in conservation is growing day by day. Two schools namely Nzoila and Kithingi'isyo primary schools were taken out on a field trip each to the Tsavo West where the Kids really learnt a lot about nature.
