#### **Monthly Summary**

This was a brief month for the team as operations were only carried out for less than two weeks. However this did not deter the team from doing its job of protecting Kenya's natural resources. The Team managed to arrest six people: four illegal grazers, one poacher and one charcoal burner before relocating to Kenze to give support to the Chyulu team. These joint operations gave the Teams adequate strength and ability to cover a large area in the Chyulu Hills National Park.

During the month of September two primary schools namely Kikwasuni and Kyusiani were taken to field trips to the Tsavo National park. The kids were very happy to see the animals and the main attractions of Tsavo west national park which they had only heard of and read about in their geography classes.
