Monthly Summary

During the first half of the Month the team proceeded with the daily patrols in the TW Triangle as the team noted illegal human activity yet again creeping back into this area. These ranged from illegal logging for wood carving, snaring, livestock grazing in the park, charcoal burning and hunting of big game such as elephant. The team therefore worked hard so as to counteract the emerging trend. The team arrested 5 men, of which 4 were apprehended for poaching of game meat and game trophies.

From the arrested men, the team was able to recover around 10 poisonous arrows, 3 knives, a sack of an used poison, an axe, 2 bows and bush meat of about 30kg. The culprits were booked at Mtito police station for poaching. The aggressive patrols carried out in September paid off as during the second half of the month, there was less illegal human activity sighted within the team's area of operation.
