

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### **De-Snaring Report for September, 2013**

#### **Monthly Summary**

#### Roka

Roka area is situated on the eastern side of the Tsavo East National Park; bordering Garsen County. This area was first area to be visited by the team and the team together with the Ithumba platoon did a joint operation to drive out illegal cattle grazers off of the Park. The herdsmen invaded the Park with many heads of cattle and they came as far as Tana River District. The team arrested eight of them and booked them at the Voi Police Station.

#### Kasala

Since this area boarder's community land, the team noted that it's become a hotspot poaching area. Most of the snares lifted during the month came from this area with 16 medium and 51 small snares being recovered. A snared dikdik carcass was found and one poacher's footprint sighted which the team believed that was the poacher who laid the snares. The team tried to lay an ambush on several occasions but no avail. The team will then focus on this area next month to ensure the safety of animals while grazing.

#### Shimo la Shetani

The team got some information that a bicycles track was sighted within this area by our Pilot on a routine air patrol. The team then followed the tracks for more than 15 kilometers towards Tiva River and managed to recover the two bicycles, however, the two poachers escaped arrest. The team believed that the poachers had intention of killing elephants and ferry the ivories using the bicycles.

#### Mathae

This area is adjacent to the Ithumba base. The team patrolled this area towards Kalovoto River for three days where the team noted that there are no major illegal activities sighted compared to the last month. A few small snares were lifted. The team also we sighted three wild dogs near the base which have been categorized as the rare species.




