A shooting blind was found and destroyed at the Tesiwa area



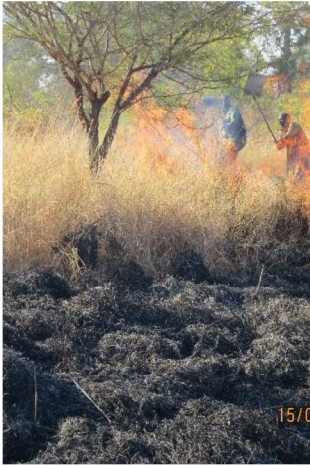
LARGE SNARES

The team continued to lift a number of snares of varying sizes set throughout the Park during the month



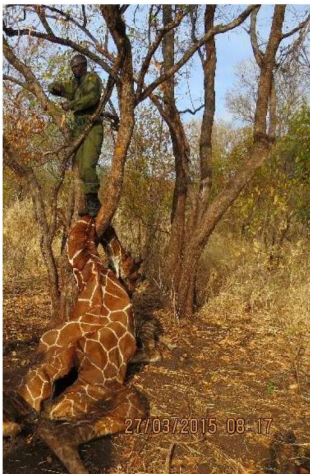
POACHERS CAMP

The team members found a recently used poacher's hideout at mlima tatu area

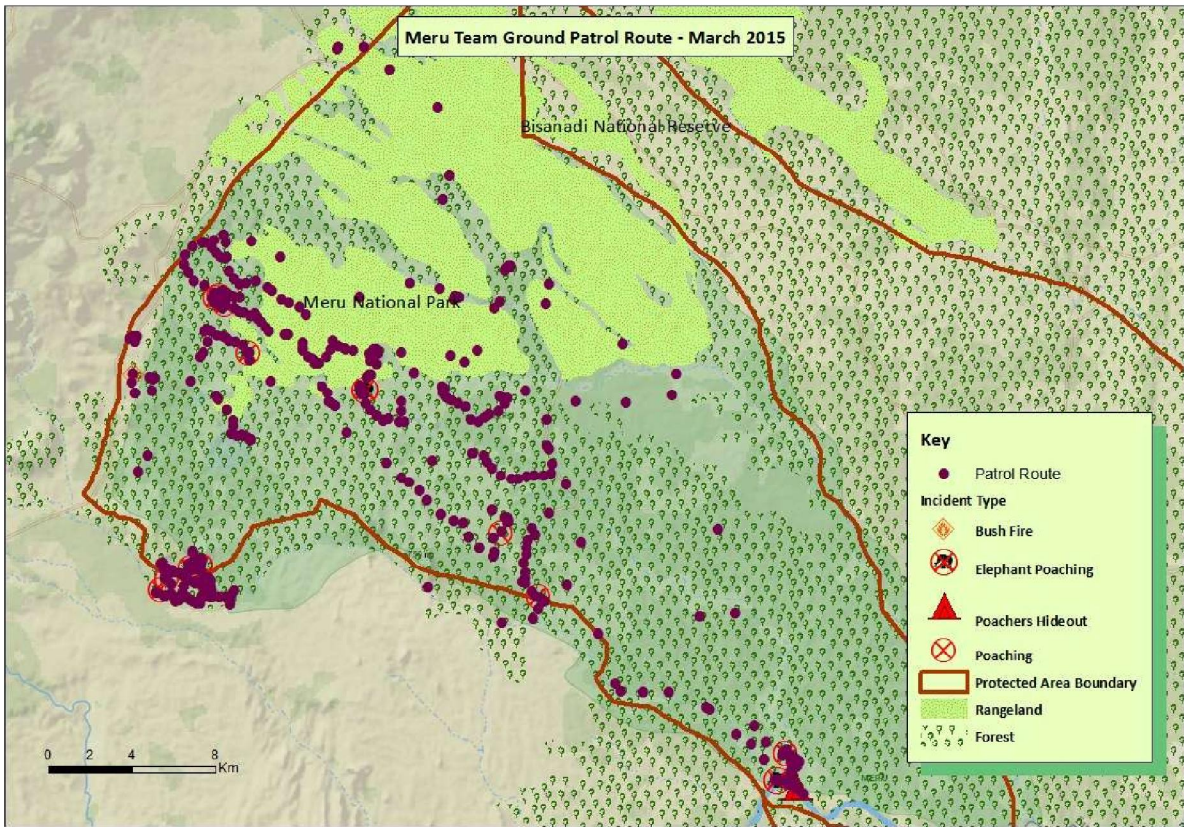


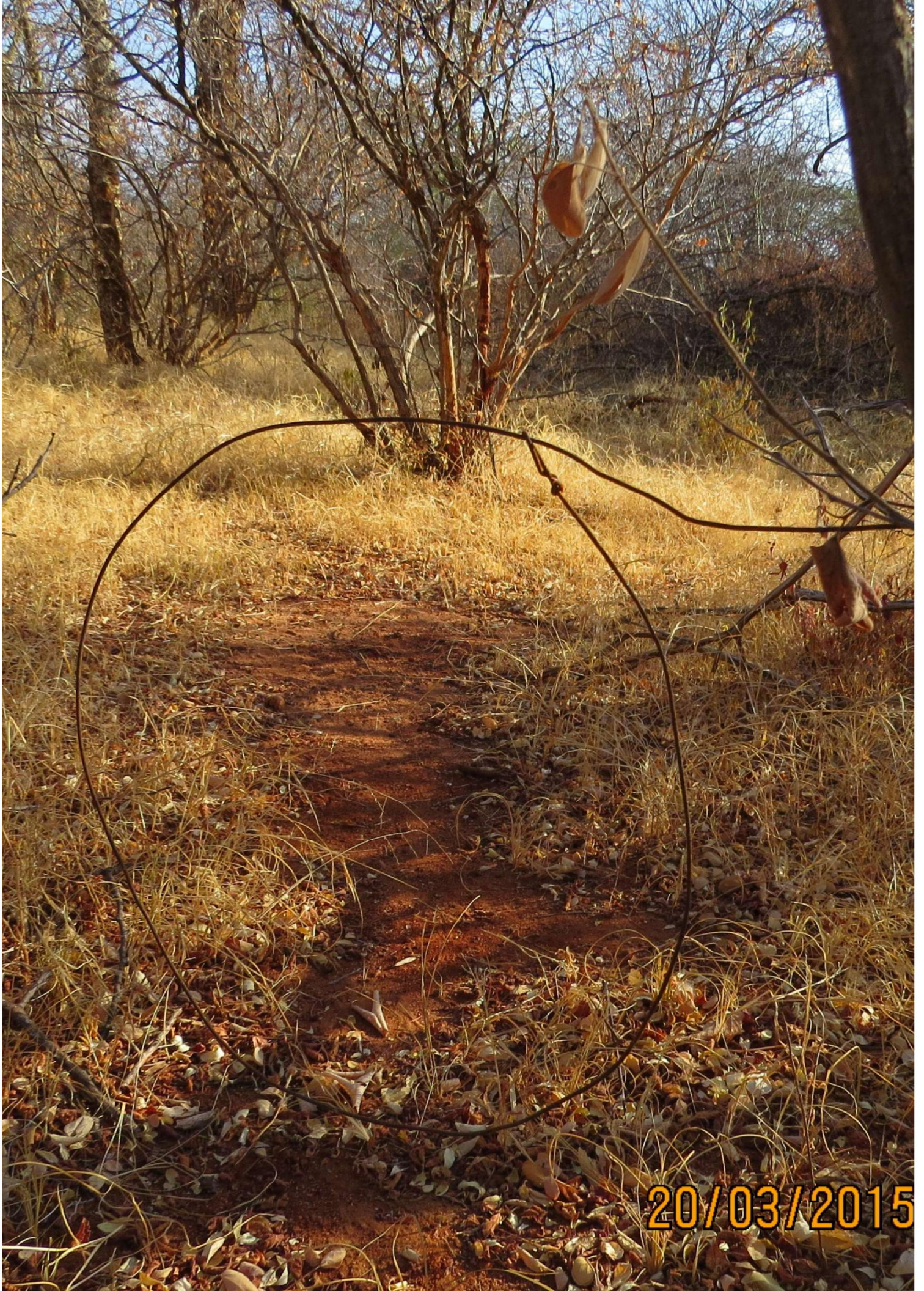
SNARED GIRAFFE
