Monthly Summary

The team resumed from off duty on 15th January and laid their camp at Wamata area. The team started its operation at Masobo area. This area being a hotspot, it's preferred by poachers due to its inaccessibility, hence making it harder to capture them. In this area the Team lifted 3 snares and destroyed a number of poacher's hideout and shooting platforms. In Tundani there is a notable decrease in cases of illegal activities.

The Team camped at Ithumba for part of the month and carried out aggressive patrols of the Mathae, Kyaerock, Lesalau dam, Kalavoto and Ithumba Airstrip. At Kyaerock area the team destroyed a very well used shooting platform. A dikdik was found & rescued from a snare at Lesalau dam, the injuries were minor and hence the animal was released. At Ithumba Airstrip the Team destroyed another very well sued shooting platform that was sighted from an aerial patrol.

The Security at Ithumba area has to be beefed up, due to the reported cases of illegal entry in the park by poachers.
