Monthly Summary

Joint operations with KWS officially resumed this month following a ban since the beginning of March. This has made the anti-poaching work far more efficient. During the first half of the month little illegal activities were witnessed in the Ithumba general area. Towards the middle of the month some of the team members went to a take part in a Ranger course at Law Enforcement Academy in Manyani.

During an aerial patrol with the Trust's pilot it was noted that large amounts of logging were taking place in areas that the team does not frequent. Immediate action on the ground followed and the team destroyed beams and logs and lifted many small snares. During patrols the team also visited known dams and found most to be dry; this meant the poachers will be following the wildlife to areas with water. Evidently most illegal activities were in areas around Tiva River.

Other activities noted in the course of the month included bush fires at Tundani area. Towards the end of the month the team undertook a joint operation at Gazi area where several fresh charcoal kilns were destroyed, many snares were lifted, and five arrests of illegal loggers and cattle grazers took place. Generally the number of illegal activities seems to be reducing; this can be attributed to the tight security measures put in place to reduce the poaching activities. The return of join work with KWS on a field level has been a huge help this month.
