Monthly Summary

The Ziwani Team was on off duty from 1st to the 12th of January. The majority of the snares lifted targeted big game. The team arrested two poachers in possession of warthog meat. The capture was thanks to a tipoff provided by an informant. One of the poachers originated from a village near the northern tip of Tsavo East National Park while the other was from the local area close to the capture location. The poachers were booked at Mtito Police Station. The Team also came across two other poachers seen crossing from the community side to the park carrying two sacks of snares. During the chase the poachers dropped their sacks and sadly got away.

This month the team donated forty quality desks as well as two thousand exercise books to Maktau Primary School. These donations were kindly donated by a donor from Germany as part of the Trusts new Community Outreach initiative via the website.

The entire community greatly appreciated this gesture and was overwhelmed by this contribution as no other institution in the area has received such extensive educational support.
