Monthly Summary

Unlike most other DSWT Desnaring Teams, who have all seen a reduction in the number of snares collected due to the arrival seen little change in the number of snares collected this month. This could be attributed to inadequate rainfall distribution arou communities failing to plant or planting and then the crop withering. As a result many poachers have not neglected their illegal The team retrieved the most snares at Taita wildlife sanctuary, all targeting big game. The Team also found four carcasses, or poaching. Two were buffaloes and one impala.

The Team came across an elephant carcass at Maktau near the airstrip with no tusks. The carcass was too decomposed to de

One poacher and one illegal miner where arrested and booked at Taveta police station. Large number of illegal cattle grazing establishing kraals (bomas) inside the park for the animals to feed and spend the night inside park.

The Team rescued an orphaned elephant at Murka area inside the park after two lions had attacked it inflicting a minor wound was flown to Nairobi to the DSWT Nursery Unit were it is being cared for. The team is suspects the mother might be a victim of numerous sighting of poached elephant in the area over the last few months.

This month the team organised three (3) ecological trips to Tsavo west National park. The three schools were Godoma primary Kenyatta high school. None of the students taken on the trip had visited the park before and were very excited to be given this The schools were went on game drives and saw animals ranging from small to big game. They also visited the main attraction The team donated sports equipments to Maktau primary school. The school praised the trusts humble gesture of donating qua to have this equipment and deeply grateful.
